We thought we'd supply an invoice encase the looming financial year is a factor in your funding and payments.

As discussed, here is the quote for two 80cm by 80cm maps. Each of these will be printed in four pieces on our FDM printers (joined for a seamless finish), coloured in a naturalistic style based on your drone/aerial photography - they can be mounted on a ply backing or a framed setting whichever suits your preference.

We will be using your topographical data supplied via a stl file to render the print files. And will make sure our renders are correct and the print files accurate.

Additionally, the maps can be finished in an epoxy varnish – this allows them to be tactile maps without risk of damaging the model or finish.

Additional changes and tweaks can be made to the design before printing. We'll make sure to clear the print files with you before starting. Tweaks to the map finish can be made before mounting.
